1. Personal Counseling

- Objective: To address personal challenges and improve mental well-being, enhancing students' academic and professional performance.
- Details:
 - Conducted by Mr. Rohit Patil, an expert in human psychology.
 - Participants: 65 students attended one-on-one sessions.
 - Highlights:

2. Domain Counseling

Details:

- Conducted by various professors who are subject experts.

- o Highlights:

3. Group Discussion (GD) and Personal Interview (PI) Sessions

 Objective: To enhance students' communication, analytical thinking, and interview skills for placements.

- o Organized by the Training and Placement Team, led by Ms. Fatima.
- Participants: 240 students actively engaged in GD/PI sessions.
- Highlights:
 - Training on handling high-pressure interviews and group discussions.
 - Mock interview sessions simulated real-world scenarios.
 - Students received constructive feedback to improve articulation, body language, and presentation skills.

4. Counseling on First-Generation Entrepreneurs

 Objective: To inspire and guide students interested in entrepreneurship, particularly those without a family business background.

Details:

- Organized under the E-Cell of the Institute.
- Participants: 20 students attended.
- o Highlights:
 - Focused on challenges and opportunities faced by first-generation entrepreneurs.
 - Included interactive sessions with guest speakers who shared real-life entrepreneurial experiences.
 - Students received actionable insights on business ideation, funding, and scaling.
